If you wish to be considered for a short (i.e. 15 min) talk, submit a one-paragraph abstract (250 words maximum) through the registration site and provide a tentative title in the appropriate box (the title can be changed later if necessary). **The deadline for submitting an abstract is February 16, 2019.** If your abstract is not selected for an oral presentation, we will automatically schedule you for a poster presentation.

If you wish to present a poster only, please enter the tentative title through the registration

site. **The deadline for submission of a poster title is February 16, 2019.** We will try to accommodate all posters. If necessary, the title of your poster can be changed prior to the symposium.

We highly encourage students and postdocs to submit abstracts to be considered for a speaker slot. This is a great opportunity to present your work to a knowledgeable but friendly audience. We also highly encourage you to present a poster.

Parking Information

The Owens Street Parking Garage at the Mission Bay campus is the closest to the venue. The rates are \$4.00 per hour with a \$32 daily maximum.

However, we are offering a parking voucher for reduced rate of \$16 all-day parking at the Community Center Garage located at 1625 Owens Street ONLY. Vouchers are only available to event attendees and can be picked up at the registration table in Genentech Hall on the day of the event. Vouchers must be presented and relinquished to the cashier upon exit in order to receive the discounted rate. This voucher is not valid on hourly rates and cannot be used outside of the event date.
